## According to

- 1. the presence of the "U. S. Army Hospital" on the map (post WWII),

- 3. the presence of the "Rakuyo Hotel" on the map (renamed to Kyoto Station Hotel in 1955) this business card appears to be from the <u>early 1950s</u>.
